



DOLPHIN JUMPING AT SUNSET INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1. Trace your dolphin design using carbon paper, shiny side down.

STEP 2. Using 1/2" Flat brush, Primary Yellow mixed with white paint, paint the center of the sun. Now only using Primary Yellow paint the sunrays every other one.

STEP 3. Rinse brush. Using Spiced Pumpkin paint the unpainted sunrays.

STEP 4. Rinse brush. Using Island Blue and the tiniest touch of black mixed in, paint the dolphin body, fins, head, top of nose and tail. Using Island blue mixed with white, paint the underbelly of the dolphin.

STEP 5. Clean your brush. Using Peacock Teal paint horizontal strokes in the back of the sea. Paint every other wave line teal in the direction of the wave. Paint Island blue in every other wave line. Keeping the paint wet, slightly blend the colors of the wave. Using white, blend a few highlights into the wave lines.

STEP 6. Clean your brush. Now using black paint the mountains in the distance. Using the thinnest part of your flat brush, paint lines separating the sun's rays. Paint a few black lines highlighting each sunray. Rinse your brush and switch to the liner brush. Using black, paint dots in between the black highlights on the sunrays. Paint the dolphins eye, and outline a few areas on the dolphin's back and fins to make him stand out.

STEP 7. Rinse your brush. Now using white and your round brush or biggest brush, smooch paint around the front and sides of the crashing wave, making foam. Paint a few wispy white lines up from the white foam as spray. Using the tip of the back of your paintbrush dip into white and place a few dots around the crashing wave.

STEP 8. Using your 1/2" Flat brush paint white highlight lines on the sunrays. Paint a white outline around the sun, then a curved white line around the inner edge of the sun. Paint a few white highlights on the dolphin's fins, flippers and top of head and nose.

You are now ready to sign your painting. Great Job!
